The Position

The Seattle Mariners Baseball Club is recruiting to fill the position of Sales Intern. The Sales Department maintains interns in each of the following quarters*

Winter Quarter - early January to mid-to-late March

Requirements

The Seattle Mariners internship program offers college students the opportunity to take the first step into the sporting industry. Interns with the Seattle Mariners are unpaid, so interns must be enrolled at an accredited four or five-year college or university leading to a bachelor or advanced degree and must receive college/university credit for their internship. The student must be able to provide proof of their college/university credit prior to starting their assignment. Priority will be given to students who attend college in the northwest region or have attended high school in Washington State.

Internships may be full-time or part-time based on student availability and department needs. The Seattle Mariners front office is at Safeco Field in Seattle, WA; interns will report to that location.

It is the Seattle Mariners goal to hire the best students into its intern program. The Mariners accept both undergraduate and graduate students into this program. Students are eligible for an internship after completing their freshman year, however, our largest population of interns on record is junior level or above.
